From the Course...

We were anticipating a different year because of the renovation project but Covid-19 caused more changes. I think we have done a good job as a group both in the Clubhouse and Pro Shop and at the shop working with ever changing opinions and circumstances. I

honestly think we are all trying to do the right thing even though there is no road map to know exactly what the right thing is.

On the outside we have adjusted some schedules, tried to decrease our mowing frequencies and really limited our normal project load. Projects around here are generally pretty inexpensive. They do require man power and at this point of the season and based on the current condition of the golf course I don't think we will change our scaled back approach in 2020.

During the next two weeks these are some of the things we will be doing around the course that I think should not be deferred. We have 5 or 6 dead trees that need to be removed and around some of those trees are some other trees that need to be trimmed. The new trees will get weeded, watered, and new mulch. Bunker edging will be completed before the scheduled Invite.

Because we are not planting flowers this year, we are going to take the opportunity to clean out the beds and add more dirt mixed with free compost from the city dump. The normal flower schedule never seems to allow us enough time to do this kind of maintenance on the annual beds and I don't want to waste the chance this year.

Pool News and Notes

The pool opened on Memorial Day under normal hours. I got it open before the city pool again this year. What an achievement.

We will operate the pool with the same rules as always. Rules like no in town guests, no outside food or beverages (this rule applies to the entire property) and mostly just an honor system if you have out of town guests won't be enforced by lifeguards, but should be followed for the good of the entire membership.

The expectations of your lifeguards are simple. We expect them to keep the occupants of the pool safe, keep garbage picked up, and bathrooms clean and tidy during pool hours. Maintenance staff is expected to maintain the pool and facilities.

Covid-19 is on our minds as we open the pool. Just like in the Clubhouse and Pro Shop we will be sanitizing more often. Just like everywhere else if you feel safe you should feel free to use the facility as you normally would, and if you don't, or prefer to wear a face covering, we won't encourage you to do different, but lifeguards will not be wearing face coverings, gloves, or monitoring your personal social distancing practices.

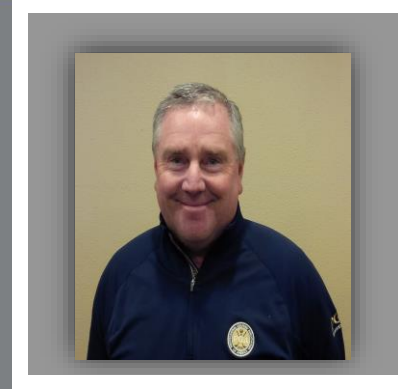
