From the Course...

This month we really start to put things away for the winter. The irrigation system will be winterized first thing followed up by any remaining snowmold applications and topdressing we have left to do. On the remaining good days we will harvest leaves and pick up debris.

I was happy to open up the golf course for some limited play this fall, but the course will officially close for the season soon. Winter golf will not be permitted this year. I covered some of the new tees to try and get a little more growing season out of them and speed up their start next spring. I expect we will be playing some alternate tees the month of April. Part of their delay is when they were seeded, another part is the ground turned out to be really hard after the construction, and I think the other part is we are mowing them pretty short, which is fine for plant health but the density, or lack of density, is a little bit easier to see at the lower height of cut.

Trees. This winter I plan to remove about 10 to 15 ash trees on 9 and 7. A number of them are storm damaged and a couple more just are not going to be missed. I think about 50% of them are going to need to be replaced and we will work on that next spring. I have some pines that are dead like normal and we will be removing them throughout the winter too. Of course all our tree work depends on if we can get out on the course. Most winters we can, but there have been some where we just can't.
